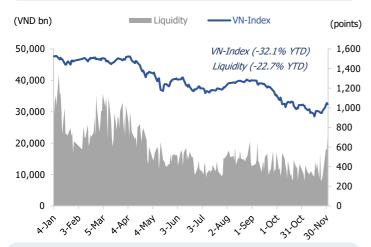

### **MARKET WRAP**

- ▼ VN-Index decreased: There were 281 advancing and 166 declining tickers. The VN-Index lost 12.1 points (-1.2%), closing at 1,036.
- ▲ Liquidity increased: Liquidity increased to VND 21,812bn, a growth of 22.8% DoD.
- ▲ Foreign investors net bought: Foreign investors net bought VND 1,025bn on HSX, with VHM (VND 211.2bn), STB (VND 147.4bn), and MSN (VND 106.0bn) the most bought.
- ▲ **Gainers:** The best-performing tickers were PDR (+7.0%), TCB (+5.8%), and PLX (+5.1%).
- ▼ Losers: The worst-performing tickers were SSI (-5.5%), VIC (-5.2%), and BID (-5.1%).

### **MARKET MOVERS**

The market adjusted itself after a series of consecutive gains. VN-Index gained strongly from the beginning of the trading session following last Friday's rally and entered the 1,050 - 1,065 point resistance area. Soon profit-taking took place with high volume causing the index to decline towards the end of the afternoon session.

**Action:** Investor should watch the market reactions when the index moved to the important psychological support of 1,000 - 1,020 points. Investors with existing stocks may take short-term profits during the next day session and wait for more suitable entry points.

 Chairman Jerome Powell confirmed that the Fed may slow down the rate of interest rate increase as soon as December 2022. After Mr. Powell's statement, DJI increased by 2.2% to 34,589.8 points, Nasdaq increased by 4.4%, to 11,468 points.

Impact: Strengthen investors' confidence in the recovery of the world economy.

# DOMESTIC NEWS

• S&P Global's Vietnam Manufacturing PMI fell below the neutral threshold of 50 points in November, ending a 13-month rally. The result of 47.4 points showed a sharp decline of business conditions compared to 50.6 points in October.

Impact: As world economic conditions worsened, Vietnam's manufacturing industry experienced a decline.

### **CORPORATE NEWS**

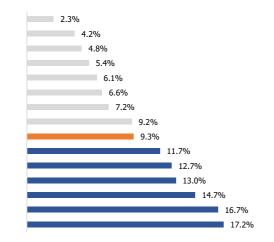
 KBC (HSX, close price on December 1st: 20,200 VND): KBC was approved to take a loan from Tan Tap Industrial Infrastructure Development Company Limited (which KBC owns 86.5%) for KBC's production and business activities. This is a one-year unsecured loan with a limit of VND 110bn.

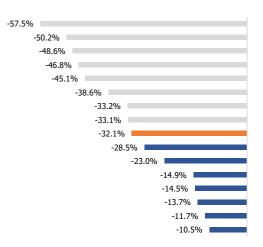

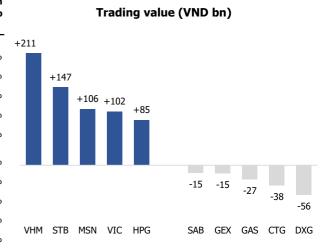

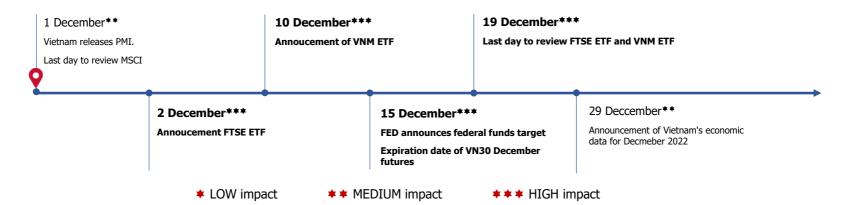
